Recent Use Examples (2016-2017)

Jun '16: PeaceHealth Sacred Heart Medical Center at River Bend develops **SOPS** for using RadResponder for routine radiation monitoring

Feb '16: DOE RAP 4, RAP 7, and EPA RERT use RadResponder to support rad/nuc preparedness operations leading up to Super Bowl 50

Jan '17: FEMA RAP 9, DOE, and others use RadResponder to support rad/nuc preparedness operations for the Rose Bowl

Oct '16: MN Rad Teams and DOE National Labs use RadResponder for sampling and analysis during the Northern Lights Exercise

May '16: Iowa REP develops draft RadResponder SOPs and begins adoption

July '16: DOE RAP 5 and EPA ERT upload samples & analysis throughout the Republican National Convention

Sep/Dec '16: FDNY monitor radiation levels during the UN General Assembly and New Year's Eve Celebrations

May '16: Colorado begins to incorporate RadResponder into their nuc/rad emergency response planning at state and local levels

Apr '16: IEMA uses RadResponder for the Braidwood NPP Full Scale Evaluated Exercise

Jul '16: DOE RAP 1 and RAP 2 upload samples & analysis throughout the Democratic National Convention

Nov '16: Kansas RCP uses RadResponder as part of ongoing monitoring and decontamination processes

Jul '16: TX DSHS uses RadResponder in the South Texas Plant Evaluated Exercise

Mar '16: Texas DSHS creates a draft CONOP for using RadResponder in a statewide response to a rad/nuc emergency

Feb '16: The FL DOH Bureau of Radiation Control uses RadResponder in a graded drill with St. Lucie NPP

National Level Applications:

- April: DHS S&T has included RadResponder in its **Response Planning Guidance for the First 100 Minutes of an RDD**
- July: RadResponder has been incorporated into the objectives for National Level Exercise **Gotham Shield 2017**
- December: the RadResponder Network has officially been incorporated into National level policy guidance in the revised **Nuclear/Radiological Incident Annex (NRIA) to the National Response Framework**
